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ABOUT THE COLLEGE



Chennai Petroleum Corporation Limited (erstwhile MRL) one of the major corporations, having a dominant presence in South India formed the CPCL Educational Trust in April 1988 with a view to upgrade the technical knowledge of the serving personnel in the Petroleum and Petrochemical Industries. CPCL Polytechnic College was started in the academic year 1989-1990 with Part-Time Diploma Course in Petroleum Engineering. From the academic year 1994 - 1995, Full-Time Diploma Course in Petroleum Engineering was started along with the Part-Time Course.

At present, the Institution is offering three Full-Time Diploma courses namely, Diploma in Petrochemical Engineering, Diploma in Mechanical Engineering and Diploma in Electronics and Communication Engineering.

CPCL Polytechnic College is approved by All India Council for Technical Education, New Delhi and affiliated to Directorate of Technical Education, Tamil Nadu.

COURSES

All the courses are approved by All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), New Delhi and affiliated to Directorate of Technical Education (DOTE), Tamil Nadu. The courses follow the curriculum of Directorate of Technical Education (DOTE), which upgrades the curriculum on a regular basis. All the programmes are conducted on semester basis. The teaching methodology focuses on classroom lectures, guest lectures, self-learning, assignments, projects, practical sessions, periodical evaluation and feedback.

The diploma courses are of 6 semesters (3 years) duration. An academic year consists of two semesters. The Odd Semester begins in June and the Even Semester in December.

DPCE

Diploma in Petrochemical Engineering (DPCE)

Petrochemical Engineering is one of the finest branches of Engineering which deals with the Petroleum, Petrochemical, Biochemicals, Nanomaterial, Fuel cell, etc. DPCE course mainly involves Unit Process, Unit Operations, design of chemical manufacturing equipments like reactors, distillation, absorption and extraction columns using computer software. The DPCE diploma graduates have got good opportunity in Petroleum, chemical industries, research organization, food and bio chemicals and other related industries like paints, polymers, pharmaceuticals, etc.

DME

Diploma in Mechanical Engineering (DME)

Mechanical Engineering (ME) is one of the core field of Engineering, covering Thermal, Design and Production streams. From automotive to production, from engine technology to air conditioning and from designing to fabricating, ME has a lot of scope for Research, Development and Employment. Hence, the focus of the Department is to bring about an all round development of the student to create a strong foundation for generating research and technical professionals in the field of ME.

STAFF AND STUDENTS DETAILS

- As per AICTE/DOTE norms, we have 20 Teaching Staff and 14 Non-Teaching Staff.
- The student's strength for the academic year 2019-2020 is 507.

ADMISSION

- Admissions are being done on merit basis. The reservation policy is adopted and tuition fees collected as per the norms of the State Government of Tamil Nadu.
- Sanctioned intake in each branch is 60 students in the First year. Sanctioned intake in Second year (Lateral Entry) in each branch is 10% of sanctioned intake of First year.
- In the academic year 2019-2020, 180 students were admitted in First year and 26 students were admitted in Second year (Lateral Entry).
